- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY – Please follow State of Georgia guidelines regarding rules posted at the Outdoor pool.
- Parents or guardians should supervise their children at all times.
- Children ages 0-15 must always have parent accompany and be in view. Children 16+ have full access to pool.
- Swimmers are expected to shower before entering pools or hot tubs.
- Personal conduct must be such that the safety for self and others are not jeopardized. No running on the pool deck or rough play allowed.
- No toys, Noodles, or inflatable tubes allowed.
- Personal floatation (Life jacket, arm floats) devices for safety are recommended. Please do not share personal floatation devices with other members or families.
- **Diving** is not permitted at Windy Hill Athletic Club. All pool entry must be feet first.
- Adults have priority for the use of lounge chairs. Please do not leave towels or personal belongings to reserve lounge chairs.
- Appropriate swimming attire is required to enter the pool. Bathing Suit, rash guard, swim trunks, water shoes.  
  
Shoes and tops are required to go inside the club.
- **No alcohol** in pool, only allowed on deck. **No Food** is allowed until further notice. No glass on the pool deck.

- We are a non-smoking facility. This applies to all outdoor areas as well.
- Music must be kept personal. Please wear headphones when listening.
- Parents should always be within an arm's length away of non-swimmers, even with a floatation device.
- Ladders are for exiting the pool. Do not play, sit, swing, or hang on the metal railings or ladder.
- Only approved swim diapers are allowed in the pool.
- Children with Swim diapers must be checked every 30 minutes and have a restroom break.
- No running on the pool deck.
- Additional Georgia State Swimming Pool and Spa Rules and Regulations regarding bather health and safety must be always followed.

*\*The outdoor pool will close immediately if thunder, lightning or tornado warnings are issued. In such cases, the pool will reopen at the discretion of the Aquatics Supervisor after a minimum of 30 minutes.*
